Founded over 400 years ago, Monterrey is Mexico's third largest city. Universidad de Monterrey is located in San Pedro Garza Garcia, a safe and prosperous suburb of Monterrey. This "city of mountains" provides us with a beautiful landscape ideal for many outdoor activities.

PROGRAM DETAILS

UDEM offers a 4 week language program. Learn Spanish while giving a helping hand! Students will be able to transfer up to 6 US credits, and will also be awarded a community service certificate. The classes will be complemented by visits to different companies and museums, such as: Cuauhtémoc Brewing Co., Mexican History Museum, Glass Museum, Contemporary Art Museum, and Garcia Caves.

COURSES AND CREDITS

Students will attend two different courses:

Spanish: 48 contact hours (beginner, intermediate or advanced)

Mexican Culture: 24 contact hours, 24 practical hours

During the second week of the program, students will visit a rural community within Nuevo Leon. In this community, they will develop their leadership and teamwork by working on a project with the people living of the community. Students will receive a certificate for this activity (90 hours of community service).
