- 3. Once approved, the Graduate and Extended Studies Office will email a copy to you and the graduate coordinator of your program. Be sure to adhere to the approved plan as you progress through your degree program.
- 4. Approval of the Plan of Study constitutes Admission to Candidacy to the master's degree and academic major and is what establishes the requirements for graduation. Specifically, the Plan of Study delineates the required and elective coursework and culminating experience needed for graduation. A student must be in Academic Good Standing and fulfill all requirements identified in the Plan of Study for conferral of the degree.
