I. Plan of Study and Application for Candidacy

- 1. All Graduate Students who have been admitted as "Admission, Pre-Candidacy (Full)" are expected to complete a Plan of Study no later than the semester they are enrolled in their 12th credit hour of graduate coursework. Meet with your graduate coordinator or advisor as assigned by your academic department, and complete the Plan of Study form accurately and neatly.
- 2. Submit the department approved and signed Plan of Study, with any required or supporting documents, to the Graduate & Extended Studies for final approval by the Graduate Director.
- 3. Once approved by the Graduate Director, the Office of Graduate & Extended Studies will mail a signed copy to you and the Graduate Coordinator of your program. File your copy in a secure place and be sure to adhere to the approved plan as you progress through your degree program.
- 4. Approval of the Plan of Study constitutes Admission to Candidacy to the master's degree and academic major and is what establishes the requirements for graduation. Specifically, the Plan of Study delineates the required and elective coursework and culminating experience needed for graduation. A student must be in Academic Good Standing and fulfill all requirements identified in the Plan of Study for conferral of the degree.
