## Egyptian Numeration System

The value of the numeral is the sum of the values of the symbols.

| Number | Symbol | Name |
| :---: | :---: | :---: |
| 1 | 1 | Stroke |
| 10 | $\cap$ | Heel bone |
| 100 | 9 | Scroll |
| 1,000 | $\chi$ | Lotus flower |
| 10,000 | 1 | Pointing finger |
| 100,000 | $\infty$ | Fish or tadpole |
| 1,000,000 | \% | Astonished person |

For example: The Egyptian numeral
is equivalent to the base10 number
$1,000+1,000+1,000+100+100+100+100+10+10+1+1+1+1=3,425$
